



Website Help:

The new website includes a pie chart that shows your activity's status as far as MMQC equipment status reporting. See below for explanation of new terms.




■ Action Pending – Work order involving MMQC is still open on equipment, repairs/upgrades have not been completed. Used to be “Repair in Progress” at USAMMA website

- Action Completed – Repairs/Upgrades have been completed on equipment affected by MMQC and related work order is closed. Used to be “Repaired” at USAMMA website.

Terms continued....



Serial Number not affected - Activity has make and model of equipment affected by MMQC but the serial number of the equipment does not fall within the range of the affected equipment. (e.g. – If there is an MMQC on the LP 12, SNs 50-100 and you have SN 125)

***If you do not have the make and model of equipment affected by an MMQC, NO ENTRY IS NECESSARY.**

“Register Equipment Status” - This is where you go to update your MMQC-affected equipment for the first time. See explanations of fields below.
