
CHAPTER 17. ASSET VISIBILITY AND THE RCS MED 250 REPORT

17-1. INTRODUCTION

This chapter discusses reporting requirements for MEDCASE program participants.

17-2. ASSET VISIBILITY REPORTING

The Asset Visibility Reporting module of AMEDDPAS automatically produces a file tape of all AMEDD property assets \$1,000 and over in unit price the first cycle in August and February. This information can be used for numerous purposes, including defense of the MEDCASE program budget.

17-3. INQUIRIES OF THE ASSET VISIBILITY FILE

Appendix F contains examples of asset visibility file reports. Other specially sequenced reports may be produced. Activities with a need to query the asset visibility file for creation of a special report should contact the USAMMA telephonically or in writing to

17-4. RECORD CONTROL SYMBOL (RCS) MED 250 REPORT

a. **CENTRALLY GENERATED.** The RCS MED 250 Report is required under the provisions of AR 40-61. It is intended as long-range 5-year equipment requirements forecast. It is used to develop and defend the MEDCASE program budget as part of the POM Process. The submission of this report is no longer a requirement of MEDCASE participants. This report is centrally generated for each MEDCASE participant and is still generated at the local level; it should be used as a management tool for strategic planning.

b. **REPORT PRODUCTION.** The RCS MED 250 Report is automatically generated with the first cycle of the fiscal year for activities operating with AMEDDPAS.
